IMPORTANT NOTE

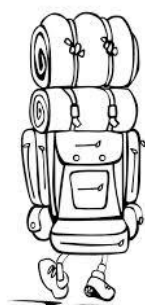
We will live an amazing scouting weekend **exclusively in nature and forests.**

The weekend will be **held entirely in English.** It is hence important for at least the unit leader to be **at ease in this language.**

- ✓ Scarves, gloves
- ✓ Raincoat + a poncho
- ✓ Flashlight
- ✓ Personal dishes
